

2020 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF THE TOWN OF STOOKEY,
ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS

MARCH 30, 2021

AS SPECIFIED AND DIRECTED BY THE ELECTORS AT THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF APRIL 9, 2019, AND PURSUANT TO PUBLIC NOTICE PROVIDED BY THE STATUTE, THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF THE TOWN OF STOOKEY WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY THE TOWN CLERK, AT THE TOWN HALL 313 EILER ROAD AT 7:00 P.M. PRESENT WERE ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS EXCEPT SUPERVISOR BONE.

THE TOWN CLERK WELCOMED THE ELECTORS TO THE MEETING AND ALL PRESENT TO PLEDGE TO THE FLAG.

THE TOWN CLERK THEN CALLED FOR NOMINATIONS FROM THE FLOOR TO ELECT A MODERATOR FOR THE MEETING. IT WAS MOVED BY RYAN STOOKEY AND SECONDED BY DAN BARGER TO NOMINATE JIM LOUGEAY AS MODERATOR. JIM LOUGEAY WAS ELECTED BY ACCLAMATION.

JIM LOUGEAY WAS GIVEN THE OATH AND TOOK THE MEETING OVER AND ANNOUNCED THAT THE MEETING WOULD BE GOVERNED BY ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER. THE MODERATOR THEN CALLED FOR THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS TOWN MEETING TO BE READ. THERE WERE NO CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS AND THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED ON A MOTION BY DAN BARGER AND SECONDED BY RYAN STOOKEY.

THE POLICE PROTECTION FUND AFTER A COMMENT ON NEEDING BETTER POLICE REPORTS BY JIM LOUGEAY WAS PASSED ON A MOTION BY RYAN STOOKEY AND SECONDED BY MARK BAGBY.

THE HIGHWAY INSURANCE LIABILITY FUND HERMAN KOESTER HAD A QUESTION ON THE IL. COUNTIES RISK MANAGEMENT PAYMENT. THE FUND WAS APPROVED ON A MOTION BY HERMAN KOESTER AND SECONDED BY JACK BRUENING.
