Rick Poole agreed to take minutes in Ryan Stookey's absence.

Meeting called to order at the Township building at 11am by co-chairman Jim Lougeay. Roll call was taken, Jim Lougeay, John Cahnovsky, Rick Poole and Kevin Borutta were present.

Minutes of the July 19, 2021 meeting were read and approved as written by unanimous vote.

There were no members of the public in attendance.

The committee began review of the Sheriff's contract. No changes to paragraphs 1 – 5 and 7 -13 were proposed "at this time". Paragraph 7 will be reviewed at the next meeting.

Jim made a motion to remove paragraph 16 pertaining to areas of patrol in its entirety. John seconded. All voted in the affirmative and motion carried.

Jim made a motion to eliminate paragraph 15 in its entirety. John seconded. All voted in the affirmative and the motion carried.

Rick made a motion to revise paragraph 6 to read as follows: "The Township agrees that the hours and time of the patrols will coincide with a regular shift at the discretion of the Sheriff in conjunction with input from Township officials".

John made a motion to change paragraph 14 to read as follows: "The County agrees to provide the Township with a monthly report of the services provided including a Patrol Report. The Patrol Report should include weekday, date, the times of patrol, time the deputy is called out of the Township and time the deputy returns to the Township if applicable, and the deputy's signature. The Township agrees to reimburse the County within thirty-two (32) days of receipt of said report at the agreed rate of consideration herein". Kevin seconded. All voted in the affirmative and the motion carried.

Jim made a motion to wait on the next committee meeting date until he has made the revisions to the contract and all committee members have had an opportunity to review it with the proposed changes. Rick seconded. All voted in the affirmative and the motion carried.

Jim made a motion at 12:34pm to adjourn the meeting. Rick seconded. All voted in the affirmative meeting was adjourned.
