Code Enforcement

The committee recommends that the two candidates currently running for sheriff (Watson and Biggs) attend our next Township meeting so residents can question them about issues, specifically derelict vehicles and why they aren't being ticketed.

Street Lighting

Mark sent out a request for the street light audit to Ameren Illinois on Friday, July 1st. I will follow up with my contact at Ameren to see if they received it.

Something we didn't discuss this meeting: New street light request at 10 Howard Street does not fit our criteria; however, after looking at it on Google Earth, I can see where we could do it. I think this should be something to discuss with the Board and let them make a decision.
